

Lunch will be at the Edelweiss Restaurant before heading to Cambridge for a tour of the Toyota Motor Manufacturing Plant. Occupying 400 acres, it is more than 3 million square feet under one roof, manufacturing approximately 1,400 vehicles per day. We will journey into the heart of Toyota to see how team members and robots build the Corolla Sedan, Lexus RX350 and the Lexus RX450 hybrid. On our guided tour aboard a motorized tram, trained guides will communicate directly to you via audio headsets. See one of the largest stamping presses in the world, enjoy a DVD Video Presentation, view interesting displays and take an opportunity to ask questions during a special question and answer time.
